- Students arriving to the examination venue out of their school uniform will not be allowed to sit for the examinations under any circumstances. (any type of hat/caps and shorts is not permitted).
- No Mobile phones or watches are allowed into the examination hall or laboratories and during full center supervision in practical examinations.
- Candidates must bring the apparatuses mentioned in the following section.
- Every school should have a school representative with an authorized letter from the school's coordinator to accompany the candidates to the exam venue.
- Parents/teachers are not allowed on exam premises during the examinations.
- Candidates may be disqualified from the examination session if they fail to comply with Cambridge International regulations.
